RE: YOUR LEGAL MATTER – FAMILY/DE FACTO LAW

We refer to our consultation with you on _____ in relation to Property Settlement/Spousal Maintenance. Limitation Periods arise in relation to both types of matters. Please be aware that you have until 12 months from the date a divorce becomes final to make a claim, otherwise your right to seek periodic support and/or division of property will be subject to obtaining the leave of the court or the consent of the other party.

In the case of de facto relationships (relationships of at least 2 years duration) property proceedings must be commenced within 2 years of the date of separation.
